1. Date for Cyber Security Presentation

The Cyber Security Presentation will take place on **Tuesday 18th June**

2. Closure of Greenwich Wharf

Transport for NSW has been planning to upgrade Greenwich Wharf. Council has recently been informed that the upgrade of Greenwich Wharf will commence on **Monday 22 April**. The project is expected to take up to 8 months to complete.

While the wharf is being upgraded there will be no ferry services to or from Greenwich Wharf. The local bus network will provide access to St Leonards and the City. The bus services will be extended into the evenings and weekends to match the existing ferry timetable while the wharf is closed.

Transport for NSW will be commencing their stakeholder engagement in the next few days which will include holding a number of pop-up information sessions, signage and the installation of a Variable Message Board in Lower Serpentine Road.

Transport for NSW will provide Lane Cove Council an information pack for the project which will be disseminated through Council social media channels, website and newsletters.
